
MH (Manual Handling)

FAW (Fire Awareness)




Comments from participants

FA (First Aid)




- •I was able to learn CPR and AED methods well. I learned how to give first aid to the injured and the importance of cooperating with others to respond quickly.

WAH (Working At Height)




- •Experiencing a rescue drill on a ladder, I realized that rescuing injured people at high altitudes is more difficult than I had imagined.

SS (Sea Survival)




- •The training was conducted in the actual sea, which made the sea breeze, the smell of the sea, and the sea surface motion more realistic and fulfilling.

BTTM (Basic Technical Training Mechanical)




- •The training was very practical because it used an actual wind turbine, so it was easy to imagine what it would be like to work on a real site.

BTTE (Basic Technical Training Electrical)





BTTH (Basic Technical Training Hydraulic)




- •I was able to learn in detail about the precautions to take when using hydraulic equipment such as oil injection. I would like to wear PPE to avoid injury and work safely.

ART (Advanced Rescue Training)




- •The course taught me how to use the rescue equipment in an applied way. The single rescue was very useful, especially because I realized how hard it is to rescue a person alone.
